Here are some short tips to help you prepare for a wildfire

- **Recognize warnings and alerts.** (DOWNLOAD THE FEMA APP To Receive Real-Time Emergency Alerts)
- **Make an emergency plan ahead of time.** Keep disaster supplies and important documents organized and readily available in case of evacuation
- **Know your evacuation zone:** You may have to evacuate quickly due to wildfires. Learn multiple evacuation routes, practice with family and identify where you will go ahead of time.

U.S. Representative Kiley requested federal funding to jumpstart numerous fire prevention projects across the Eastern Sierra

- \$1.5 million to build a 2-million-gallon water storage tank in Georgetown
- \$6.7 million for fire hydrants and water lines across the Tahoe region
- \$5 million to replace Loyaltown's main water line

U.S. Representative Kevin Kiley has co-sponsored:

- The Proven Forest Management Act – accelerates removing forest fuels and implements active forest management practices
- Direct Hire to Fight Fires Act – Reduces time needed to hire wildland firefighters
- Forest Protection and Wildland Firefighter Safety Act – Protects the ability of firefighters to use fire retardant to fight wildfires
- H.R.176 – Prevents the federal government from taxing compensation received for wildfire damage and establishes a tax credit for associated court costs
