Congressman Kiley secures crucial funds for Tahoe Area firefighting and water supplies

\$1.25 Million for Kings Beach Fire Suppression and Drinking Water Improvements

Kings Beach will soon be able to replace old and undersized water pipes, install new fire hydrants, and improve water supply for fire suppression.

These crucial projects are the result of the \$1.25 million that Congressman Kiley was able to secure for the North Tahoe Public Utility District.

\$1 Million for South Tahoe Water Project

The House of Representatives adopted Congressman Kiley's request for \$1,000,000 to replace deteriorating waterlines, improve infrastructure, and install new fire hydrants.

The funds will enhance the resilience of critical water infrastructure in South Tahoe.

Kiley Co-Sponsors Lake Tahoe Restoration Reauthorization Act

Congressman Kiley is co-sponsoring the Lake Tahoe Restoration Reauthorization Act. This bipartisan legislation reauthorizes \$415 million in funding through September 30, 2034 to reduce the threat of wildfire, combat invasive species, improve water clarity, and restore the environment in the Lake Tahoe Basin. Since its original enactment 20 years ago, funds have gone to more than 700 projects in the Tahoe Basin.
