I voted for the House Tax Reform bill – the “Tax Cuts and Jobs Act” – because it lowered taxes on the vast majority of middle-income families, small businesses and family farmers.

I was sworn in to protect our freedoms and to get the federal government out of the way. The tax reform bill was a start, but there is more work to be done.

The “Tax Cuts and Jobs Act” Congressman LaMalfa voted for is already making a difference for North State families.

- ✔ A typical middle-income family of four in the 1st District will see a tax cut of \$2,088 starting in 2018.*
- ✔ The Standard Deduction increases from \$6,500 to \$12,000 for individuals and from \$13,000 to \$24,000 for married couples. This means more money in your pocket without the extra expense of a complicated tax return.
- ✔ The Child Tax Credit is raised from \$1,000 to \$2,000. (Over 45,000 North State families will save over \$45 million annually thanks to the expansion of the child tax credit.)*
- ✔ \$1,400 of the Child Tax Credit is available to low income families even if they have no tax liability.
- ✔ The Medical Expense deduction is expanded for medical expenses exceeding 7.5 percent of adjusted gross income for 2 years.
- ✔ Eliminates tax penalty on people who can't afford to buy health insurance
- ✔ The Home Mortgage Interest Deduction is preserved up to \$750,000.
- ✔ Lowers tax rates for families, individuals, and small businesses.
