Urgent Inflation Report from U.S. Representative Doug LaMalfa



President Joe Biden's economic policies are a failure.

The latest financial reports paint a dim economic outlook. Wholesale Inflation continues to skyrocket, up over 11% last month¹ alone. This is a clear indicator that the inflation rates we are seeing are here for the foreseeable future unless action is taken.

Gas prices are up 52% over last year² and families pay almost 13% more² to feed themselves. Americans are straining their budgets to make ends meet.

This can't go on without some sort of action to reverse course. If you think inflation is bad now, look at President Biden's 2023 budget and all the spending increases proposed in Washington.
